Saturday, October 6 (L, D)

Early morning departure from Cincinnati for Batavia, New York. Overnight in Batavia, NY at the Clarion Hotel. Stops will be made en route. Lunch and dinner are included today.

Sunday, October 7 (B, D)

Enjoy included breakfast. Arrive in Stockbridge in the mid afternoon. Visit the Norman Rockwell Museum. See many of the illustrator's works in the original oil paintings. Check-in to the Jiminy Peak Resort in Hancock, MA. Enjoy included dinner before retiring for the evening.

Monday, October 8 (B, D)

Following breakfast the day begins with a Berkshire Cottages Tour. The Berkshires are known as the "Inland Newport" and display mansions built during the turn of the century before the days of income tax. These estates were also called cottages and were the homes of *Andrew Carnegie*, *Harley Proctor* of Proctor and Gamble, *George Westinghouse*, the *Vanderbilts*, and many others who formed the American Aristocracy. Next stop is Tanglewood, home of the Boston Symphony and Boston Pops. Early afternoon arrival at Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market for lunch on your own. The afternoon encourages you to take a stop back in time and includes a Boston City tour visiting the Old North Church and viewing the USS Constitution ("Old Ironsides"). Dinner this evening will be at the Chateau Restaurant in Andover, MA. Our accommodations will be at the Spring Hill Suites in Andover, MA.

Tuesday, October 9 (CB, D)

Enjoy breakfast and then depart for a fun filled day beginning in Maine on a narrated driving tour of the coastal villages of Kennebunk & Kennebunkport. Visit the Franciscan Monastery with its nicely groomed

lawns, outdoor shrines and chapel. Once again we take a step back in time to America's Grand Trolley era at the Seashore Trolley Museum. Take a scenic ride through the Maine countryside and enjoy the fall foliage on a restored streetcar. A visit to the Maine Lighthouse is included. A classic Lobster dinner is in store tonight at Jonathan's Restaurant. Feast on lobster or steak, plus chowder, corn on the cob, Maine potatoes and dessert! Our overnight stay will be at the Meadowmere Resort in Ogunquit, ME.

Wednesday, October 10 (CB, D)

Following breakfast, check-out of the Meadowmere Resort and drive to New Hampshire. We'll arrive in North Conway, NH where you will have time for shopping and lunch on your own. After lunch, board our motorcoach for a scenic drive along the Kancamagus Highway, one of the most scenic routes in America which winds through the White Mountains of New Hampshire. Included stops are the Albany covered bridge, Rocky Gorge and the Sugar Hill overlook. A stop will be made at the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway where you will have spectacular views of the White Mountains. Accommodations for the next two nights will be the Mountain Club Resort in Lincoln, NH. Dinner in our hotel.

Thursday, October 11 (B, D)

After breakfast, the day begins as we travel south for a scenic drive to Winnepesaukee. Board the M/S Mount Washington for a one-way cruise across Lake Winnepesaukee. We disembark in Wolfeboro, the oldest summer resort in America. Time for shopping and lunch on your own. This afternoon we will visit the Wright Museum, a museum about World War II with both war exhibits and exhibits of daily life from that era. Dinner this evening will be on Café Lafayette dinner train. Enjoy this delightful and delicious experience.

Friday, October 12 (B, D)

After breakfast travel to Quechee Gorge, Vermont's little grand canyon. Upon arrival time will be given to enjoy the natural wonder and shopping. Travel on the back roads to Sugarbush Farms where you will enjoy visits to a Maple Syrup Farm and a Cheese Farm. Sampling is mandatory!!
